

3rd Millennium Learning Award: Consent form

This form covers all material used in applications for the 3rd Millennium Learning Award including photographic/video images, audio commentary/comments and personal details used in submissions for the 3rd Millennium Learning Award.

Naace operates the Award scheme known as the 3rd Millennium Learning Award. In order to apply for the Award schools create a video made public to parents and others, and an accompanying video commentary for members of Naace, to feature learning enabled by technology.

The primary use of the materials for which you are giving consent is to support the professional development of teachers and the improvement of schools.

As the videos will contain images of children under 16 years old for whom the consent of a parent or guardian is required we will assume that the school already has an agreement in place with parents or guardians so that the school may sign this Consent Form on behalf of the children. Copies of this form may be supplied to parents/guardians of children who appear in the videos if the school so wishes.

Legal clauses - these apply to all areas of the form

Signing this form gives agreement that the school and all individuals who appear in the videos and other information provided by the school for their 3rd Millennium Learning Award submission give consent to the full use of material in whole or in part by Naace and its approved contractors and organisations for the purpose of promoting school improvement and professional development of educators. The material and personal details will not be used for any other purposes.

The copyright of materials generated as a result of this activity remains with the school.

The Data Protection Act stipulates that you are entitled to withdraw your consent at any time in the future should you wish to. You may do this by writing to us at the address provided below. This agreement is governed by the law of England and Wales.

The link to the promotional/parent video will be on the public side of the Naace website. The link to the commentary video will be on the members-only side of the Naace website. Naace will download and store the videos as the evidence against which the 3rd Millennium Learning Award is granted. Naace may also make compilations of sections of the videos for use to aid professional development and school improvement activities by Naace members and in this case the school will be credited in the notes associated with that compilation.
